# \*\*\* DEVELOPMENTS ORGANISATIONAL CHANGES NWO AND FOM \*\*\*



On 13 October the Organisational Plan for the NWO transition, which includes FOM, has been published. An executive summary of this plan is also available. This document can be found via the FOM website.

The new structure of NWO will start 1 Januari 2017.

The most important message for you as an employee of FOM is that at this moment we expect that the existing contracts will not change and will be continued until the enddate of your contract. Changes in funding schemes for researchers will be announced well ahead of any change.

The plan focusses on the proces of designing the new organisation. More details will follow in the coming months. We will keep you updated.

#### **COR advice on NWO transition**

Recently FOM asked the COR for advice on the intention of NWO and FOM to transform and integrate FOM in a new NWO organization. The COR understands the intention and the motives of the FOM Governing Board, but at the moment the consequences are not yet clear. Plans for the new organization will be formed in the months to come. Therefore the COR thinks that, at this stage, it is not desirable that FOM already commits to the outcome of these plans.

The COR advises FOM to cooperate for now in designing the new organization, ensuring that the best practices of FOM are anchored in the new organization, and ensuring that a coherent and adroit new organization is formed, in which the FOM values and the FOM culture are recognizable. Regarding the splitting of the organization, the ending of the FOM-foundation and the integration in the new organization, the COR advises FOM to await making a decision until the point where the plans are more mature and it is completely clear what these

plans mean for FOM employees.

In the coming weeks the COR will be busy formulating an advice on the Action Plan for the transition to a renewed NWO. We welcome the input of all FOM-employees.
